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## WEEK 9 BOTTOM TAPESTRY PANEL ROWS 1-21

#### Pattern Notes

- This part is crocheted in tapestry crochet again, back and forth in rows at the bottom of the blanket.
- Important Note: Don't use the tapestry technique at the beginning and end of each row. Begin each row with Yarn A, change to a new colour as stated and continue with both yarns to the last repeat with contrast color at the end of the row. Drop new color after last repeat with contrast yarn and finish it with Yarn A only. On the next row, pick up contrast color as stated. Make sure floats of yarn always stay on the WS.

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Row 1.** With <u>WS facing you</u>, join Yarn A with ss in ch2-sp in the corner. Yarn A: ch2 (*doesn't count as dc - here and throughout*), dc in same sp, 15dc, dc2tog; \*Yarn D: 2dc in next st, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 15dc, dc2tog; repeat from \* 7 more times; Yarn D: 2dc in next st, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 15dc, dc2tog over next st and next ch2-sp, turn - 215 sts.

**Row 2 RS.** On this and all next EVEN rows work with sc, changing yarn as per pattern of previous row. Ch1 (doesn't count as sc - here and throughout), 215sc, changing yarn as per previous row, turn - 215 sts.

Row 3 WS. Yarn A: ch2, 15dc, dc2tog; \*Yarn D: 2dc in next st, 3dc, 2dc in next st;

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Yarn A: dc2tog, 13dc, dc2tog; repeat from \* 7 more times; Yarn D: 2dc in next st, 3dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 15dc, turn.

Row 4. As Row 2.

Row 5. Yarn A: ch2, 13dc, dc3tog; \*Yarn D: 3dc in next st, dc2tog; Yarn A: 3dc in next st; Yarn D: dc2tog, 3dc in next st; Yarn A: dc3tog, 9dc, dc3tog; repeat from \* 7 more times; Yarn D: 3dc in next st, dc2tog; Yarn A: 3dc in next st; Yarn D: dc2tog, 3dc in next st; Yarn A: dc3tog, 13dc, turn.

Row 6. As Row 2.

Row 7. Yarn A: ch2, 11dc, dc3tog; \*Yarn D: 3dc in next st, dc3tog; Yarn A: 3dc in next st, 1dc, 3dc in next st; Yarn D: dc3tog, 3dc in next st; Yarn A: dc3tog, 5dc, dc3tog; repeat from \* 7 more times; Yarn D: 3dc in next st, dc3tog; Yarn A: 3dc in next st, 1dc, 3dc in next st; Yarn D: dc3tog, 3dc in next st; Yarn A: dc3tog, 11dc, turn.

Row 8. As Row 2. Cut Yarn D for Colour Crafter version only.

**Row 9.** Yarn A: ch2, 10dc, dc2tog; \*Yarn D (*E for Colour Crafter version*): 2dc in next st, 1dc, dc2tog; Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 5dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn D (E): dc2tog, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 3dc, dc2tog; repeat from \* 7 more times; Yarn D (E): 2dc in next st, 1dc, dc2tog; Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 5dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn D (E): dc2tog, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 5dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 10dc, turn.

Row 10. As Row 2.

Row 11. Yarn A: ch2, 9dc, dc2tog; \*Yarn D (E): 2dc in next st, 1dc, dc2tog; Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 7dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn D (E): dc2tog, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 1dc, dc2tog, repeat from \* 7 more times; Yarn D (E): 2dc in next st, 1dc, dc2tog; Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 7dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn D (E): dc2tog, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 9dc, turn.

Row 12. As Row 2.

**Row 13.** Yarn A: ch2, 8dc, dc2tog;

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\*Yarn D (E): 2dc in next st, 1dc, dc2tog; Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 9dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn D (E): dc2tog, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc3tog; repeat from \* 7 more times; Yarn D (E): 2dc in next st, 1dc, dc2tog; Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 9dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn D (E): dc2tog, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 8dc, turn.

Row 14. As Row 2.

Row 15. Yarn A: ch2, 7dc, dc2tog; Yarn D (E): 2dc in next st, 1dc, dc2tog; \*Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 11dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn D (E): dc2tog, 5dc, dc2tog; repeat from \* 7 more times; Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 11dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn D (E): dc2tog, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 7dc, turn.

Row 16. As Row 2. Cut Yarn D (E).

**Row 17.** Yarn A: ch2, 6dc, dc2tog; Yarn B (*C for Colour Crafter version*): 2dc in next st, 1dc, dc2tog; \*Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 13dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn B (C): dc2tog, 3dc, dc2tog; repeat from \* 7 more times; Yarn A: 2dc in next st, 13dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn B (C): dc2tog, 1dc, 2dc in next st; Yarn A: dc2tog, 6dc, turn.

**Row 18.** As Row 2.

**Row 19.** Yarn A: ch2, 7dc; Yarn B (C): 4dc; \*Yarn A: 17dc, Yarn B (C): 5dc; repeat from \* 7 more times; Yarn A C: 17dc; Yarn B (C): 4dc; Yarn A: 7dc, turn.

**Row 20.** Note: All popcorns (pc) are made with tr and are "modified". Make first tr around indicated st and then work the next four tr into the loop formed at the base of the first leg. Change color in finishing ch after pc. Yarn A: ch1, 7sc; Yarn B (C): 4sc; \*Yarn A: 8sc; Yarn B (C): pc around st of Row 18 directly below next st of Row 19, skip 1 st on Row 19; Yarn A: 8sc; Yarn B (C): 5sc; repeat from \* 8 more times making 4sc instead of 5sc in last repeat; Yarn A: 7sc, turn.

Row 21. As Row 19.
