Gauge/Tension

16 sts and 22 rows to measure 10 x 10cm over st using 5.5mm needles.

Measurements (in cm)

Abbreviations

[] number of sts on a given round

beg beginning

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together: insert needle kwise into first two sts and knit them together

p purl

pm place stitch marker

rem remain(ing)

rep(s) repeat(s)

RS right side

st(s) stitch(es)

st st stocking stitch: RS knit, WS purl

WS wrong side

SHOPPING LIST

Pretty Little Things shopping lists can be cut out and taken along to your local yarn store when picking up supplies for your projects!

BASIC BOBBLE BEANIE

Scheepjes Chunky Monkey

(100% Premium Acrylic (Anti Pilling); 100g/116m)

Yarn A: 1065 Sage x 1 ball or 1035 Maroon x 1 ball or 1823 Mustard x 1 ball
Mustard x 1 ball

Yarn B: 1035 Maroon x 1 ball or 1823 Mustard x 1 ball or 1065 Sage x 1 ball

5.5mm double pointed needles or circular needle, 80cm long for magic loop

Stitch marker

8.5cm pompom maker (item no. CL3126)

Pattern Notes

Beanie is worked bottom up in the round. Measurements are based off average sizes, so to ensure correct size, measure your favourite beanie to check. To adjust length, work more or fewer rounds of Body between Band and Crown Decreases.

Instructions

BAND

With Yarn A and long tail cast-on method, cast on 72 (80: 88) sts and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Pm to mark beg of round.

Round 1 (RS) *K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rounds 2-8 Rep Round 1.

BODY

Round 9 K to end.

Work 21 (24: 26) more rounds in st st.

CROWN DECREASES

Note: Make sure to work as noted for your size.

Size Adult L-XL only

Next round *K9, k2tog; rep from * to end. [80 sts]

Next round K to end.

Sizes Adult S-M and Adult L-XL only

Next round *K8, k2tog; rep from * to end. [72 (72) sts]

Next round K to end.

All Sizes

Round 1 *K7, k2tog; rep from * to end. [64 sts]

Round 2 K to end.

Round 3 *K6, k2tog; rep from * to end. [56 sts]

Round 4 K to end.

Round 5 *K5 k2tog; rep from * to end. [48 sts]

Round 6 K to end.

Round 7 *K4, k2tog; rep from * to end. [40 sts]

Round 8 K to end.

Round 9 *K3, k2tog; rep from * to end. [32 sts]

Round 10 *K2, k2tog; rep from * to end. [24 sts]

Round 11 *K1, k2tog; rep from * to end. [16 sts]

Round 12 *K2tog; rep from * to end. [8 sts]

Fasten off and draw yarn through rem sts. Pull tight.

To Finish

Weave in ends and block Beanie to measurements.

With Yarn B and pompom maker, make one large pompom and fasten to top of Beanie.

CRAZY COOKIE CUSHION

Measurements

35 x 42cm

Gauge/Tension

13 sts and 13 rows to measure 10 x 10cm over dc using a 5mm hook.

13 sts and 10 rows to measure 10 x 10cm over Cable Stitch using a 5mm hook.

Abbreviations

[] number of sts on a given row/round

ch(s) chain(s) or chain st(s)

dc double crochet

rep(s) repeat(s)

ss slip stitch(es)

st(s) stitch(es)

yoh yarn over hook

***.....; rep from * once more/twice more/3 more times/to end** work the instructions after * and then repeat that section as specified

Special Abbreviations

tr-co treble crochet cross-over: working over the prev 3 tr, yoh, insert hook through skipped st front to back, yoh, pull up loop to height of tr, (yoh, draw through 2 loops) twice

Pattern Notes

Cushion is worked continuously in a spiral without closing each round with a ss. Place stitch marker in first st of each round and move it up as you go. Cable Stitch consists of (skip 1 st, 3tr, tr-co).

Instructions

With Yarn A, ch 92, join to first ch with ss, make sure foundation ch is not twisted. Continue in same st.

Round 1

Rep Round 1 another 11 times, alternate colour per round in following order: B, A, C, A.

Change to Yarn A.

Round 13

*Skip 1 st, 3tr, tr-co: rep from * to end.

[23 Cable Sts]

Change to Yarn B.

Round 14

Rep Rounds 13-14 another 11 times, alternating between Yarn B and Yarn C when working Round 14.

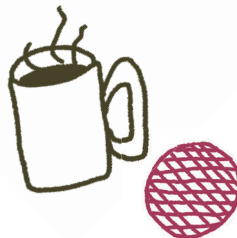
Change to Yarn A.

Round 37

Rep Round 37 another 10 times, alternate colour per round in following order: B, A, C, A.

To Finish

Block Cushion to measurements. Insert cushion insert and dc top and bottom edges together with Yarn A. Weave in all ends. With Yarn B and pompom maker, make four large pompoms and fasten to corners of Cushion.

(Anti Pilling); 100g/116m)

Yarn A: 1829 Teal x 2 balls

Yarn B: 1435 Magenta x 2 balls

Yarn C: 1114 Golden Yellow x 1 ball

5mm crochet hook

40 x 45cm cushion insert

70mm pompom maker
(item no. 98707)

Stitch marker

AUTUMN'S EYE HANGER

Measurements

ø 40cm (excluding tassels)

Abbreviations

cw clockwise

ccw counterclockwise

rep repeat

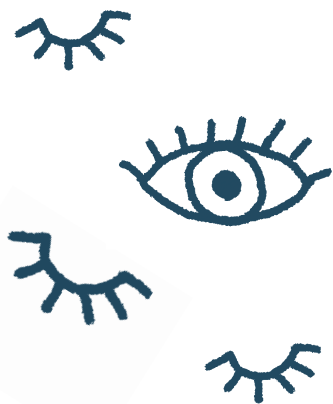
tog together

WS wrong side

***.....; rep from * until ...** work the instructions after * and then repeat that section as specified

Pattern Notes

Autumn's Eye Hanger is made by wrapping yarn clockwise or counterclockwise around bundled sticks. Use your fingers to adjust the yarn to make sure wraps are even on all sticks. Tassels are added to finish off.



Instructions

HANGER

Round 1 Mark middle of sticks with a pencil and place one stick over another, creating a cross. With Yarn A, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once cw around first stick (above middle point where sticks cross), rep for second stick wrapping yarn once cw. Continue around until wraps measure ø 3cm to make first Eye. Fasten off and tie yarn tails together.

Round 2 With Yarn B and two remaining sticks, rep Round 1. Place Yarn A Eye on top of Yarn B Eye.

Round 3 With Yarn C, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once ccw around first stick (Note: This stick is wrapped before with Yarn A), *skip 1 stick by bringing yarn underneath wraps of Yarn B and wrap yarn once ccw around next stick; rep from * until 8 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 4 With Yarn D, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once ccw around first stick (Note: This stick is wrapped before with Yarn C), *skip 1 stick by bringing yarn over wraps of Yarn B and wrap yarn once ccw around next stick; rep from * until 10 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 5 With Yarn E, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once cw around first stick (Note: This stick is wrapped before with Yarn B), *skip 1 stick by bringing yarn over other wraps and wrap yarn once cw around next stick; rep from * until 4 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 6 With Yarn F, hold yarn tail at WS and

AUTUMN'S EYE HANGER

Scheepjes Chunky Monkey

(100% Premium Acrylic
Anti Pilling); 100g/116m

Yarn A: 1029 Rust x 1 ball

Yarn B: 1709 Ochre x 1 ball

Yarn C: 1023 Salmon x 1 ball

Yarn D: 1823 Mustard x 1 ball

Yarn E: 1708 Petrol x 1 ball

Yarn F: 1035 Maroon x 1 ball

Yarn G: 1065 Sage x 1 ball

Yarn H: 1828 Grape x 1 ball

4 x 40cm, ø 5mm wooden sticks





NOTES

wrap yarn once ccw around first stick (Note: This stick is wrapped before with Yarn E), *skip 1 stick by bringing yarn underneath other wraps and wrap yarn once ccw around next stick; rep from * until 10 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 7 With Yarn G, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once cw around first stick (Note: This stick is wrapped before with Yarn D), *skip 1 stick by bringing yarn over other wraps and wrap yarn once cw around next stick; rep from * until 5 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 8 With Yarn B, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once cw around any stick over other wraps, continue around until 6 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 9 With Yarn H, hold yarn at WS and wrap yarn once ccw around first stick (Note: This stick is wrapped before with Yarn G), *skip 1 stick by bringing yarn over other wraps and wrap yarn once ccw around next stick; rep from * until 14 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 10 With Yarn E, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once ccw around first stick (Note: This stick is wrapped before with Yarn F), *skip 1 stick by bringing yarn underneath other wraps and wrap yarn once ccw around next stick; rep from * until 14 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 11 With Yarn C, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once cw around any stick over other wraps, continue around until 7 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 12 With Yarn D, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once ccw around first stick (Note: This stick is wrapped before with Yarn E), *skip 1 stick

by bringing yarn over other wraps and wrap yarn once ccw around next stick; rep from * until 8 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 13 With Yarn A, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once ccw around first stick (Note: This stick is wrapped before with Yarn H), skip 1 stick by bringing yarn underneath other wraps and wrap yarn once ccw around next stick; rep from * until 8 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

Round 14 With Yarn G, hold yarn tail at WS and wrap yarn once cw around any stick, continue around until 7 wraps per stick, fasten off and tie yarn tails tog.

To Finish

Weave in all ends.

TASSELS

Cut 18 x 20cm strands of Yarn F, 6 x 20cm strands of Yarn D and 4 x 20cm strands of Yarn C. Fold in half and finish Tassel by wrapping piece of Yarn F around looped end. Rep for second Tassel.

Cut 18 x 24cm strands of Yarn E, 6 x 20cm strands of Yarn B and 4 x 20cm strands of Yarn F. Make Tassel as per instructions for first Tassel.

With corresponding yarn, tie tassel onto Autumn's Eye Hanger, using photo as guide.
